\*Identity theft was the criminal offense for both reported theft incidents.

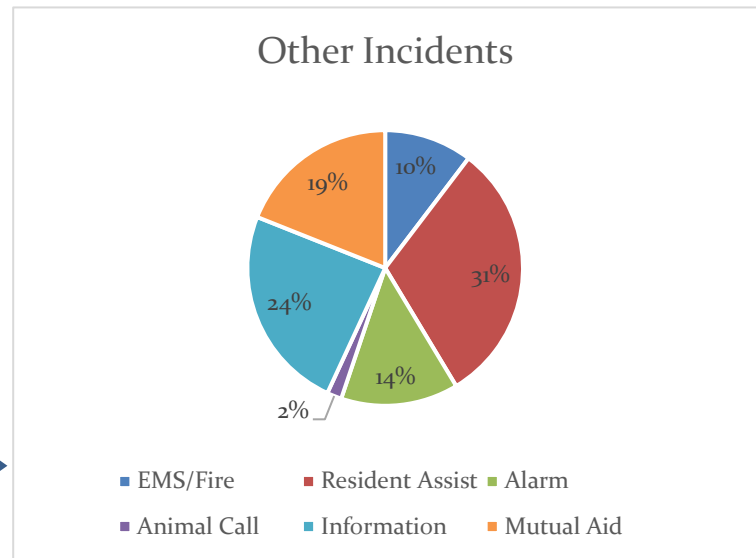
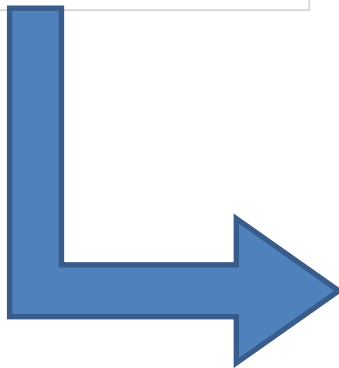
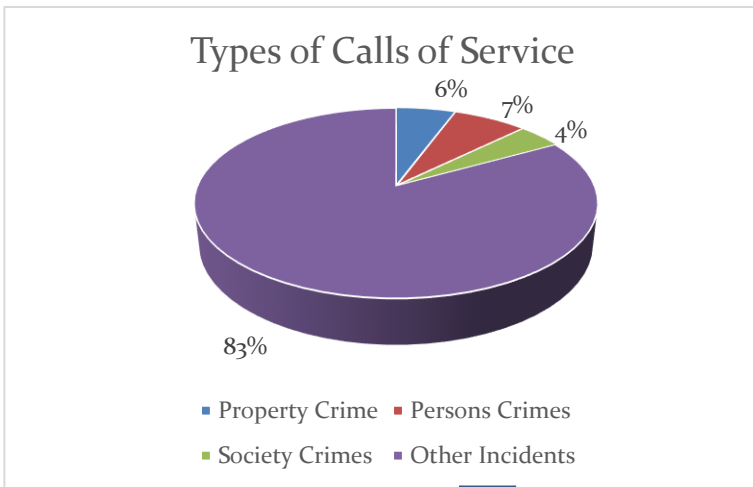

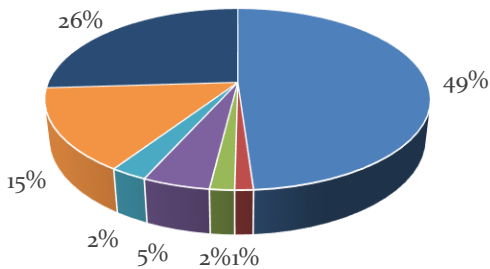
