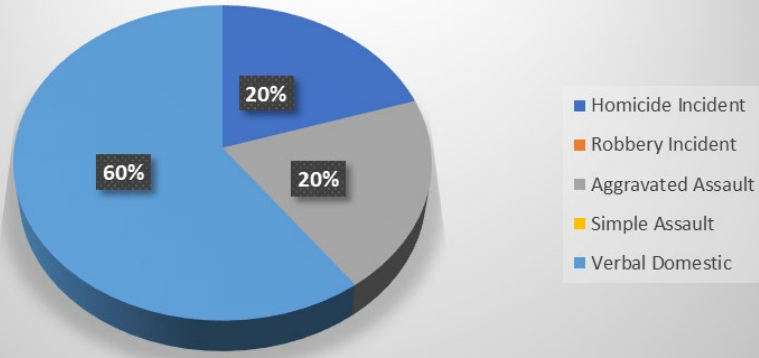

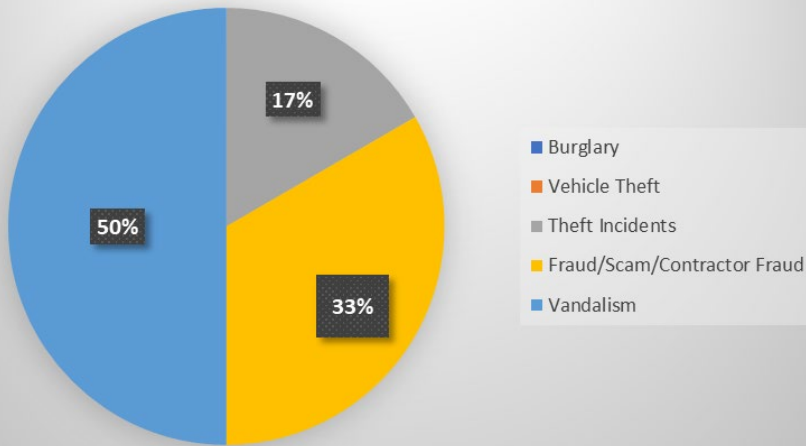

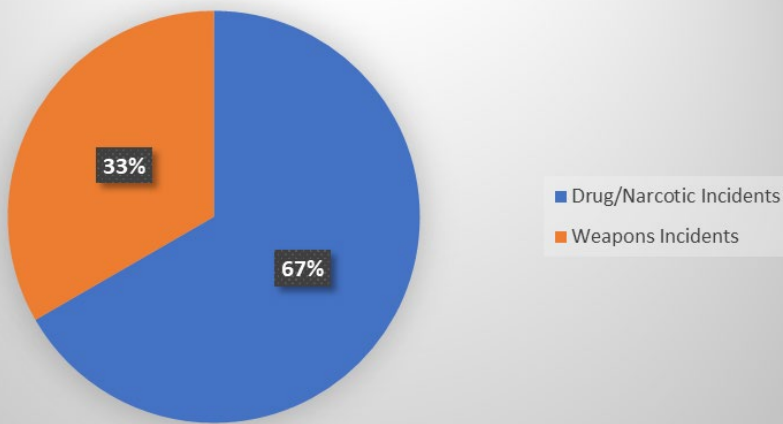
Person Crimes Month



Property Crimes Month

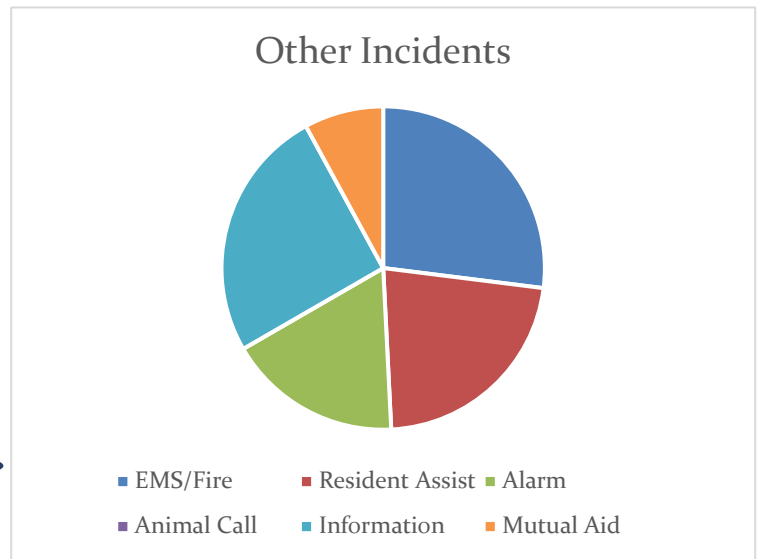
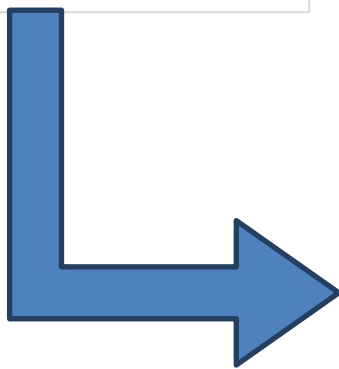
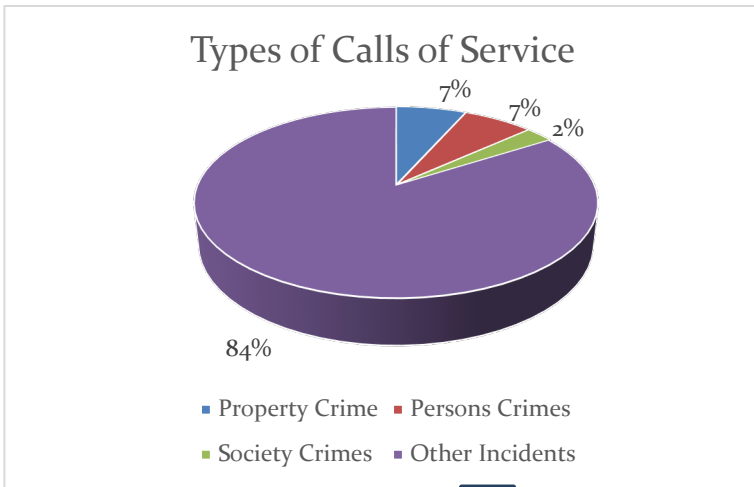


Society Crimes Month

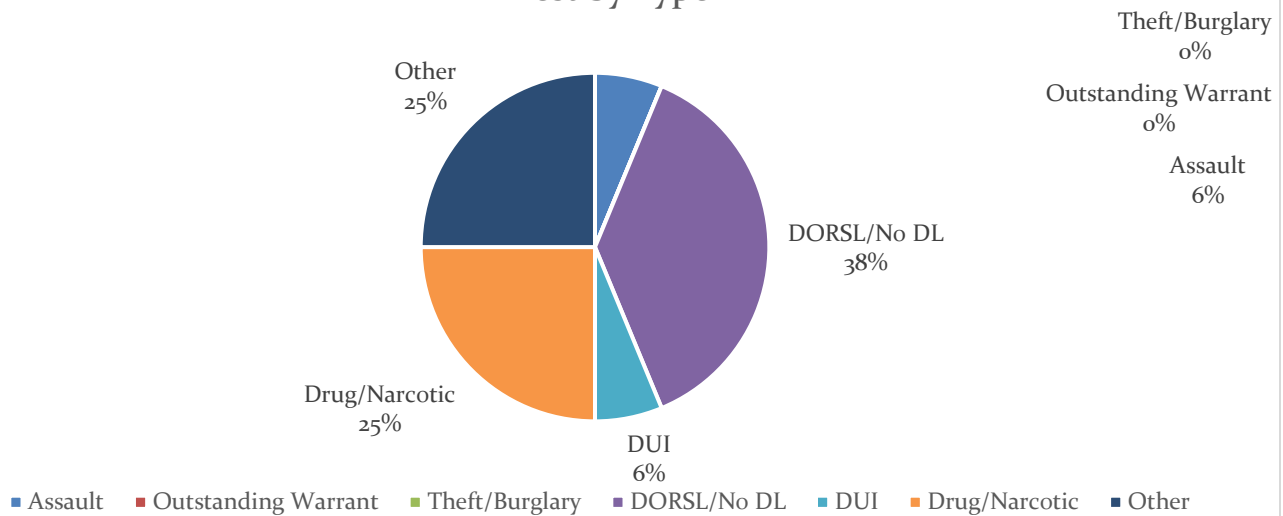


Arrests

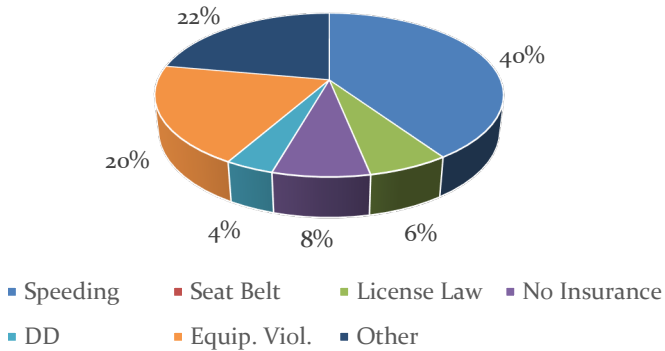
Arrest by Type



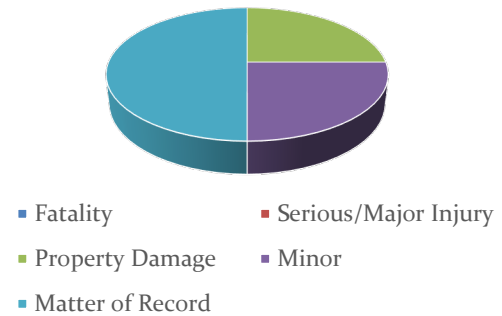
