The object of Crimes Against Property, e.g., robbery, bribery, and burglary, is to obtain money, property, or some other benefit.

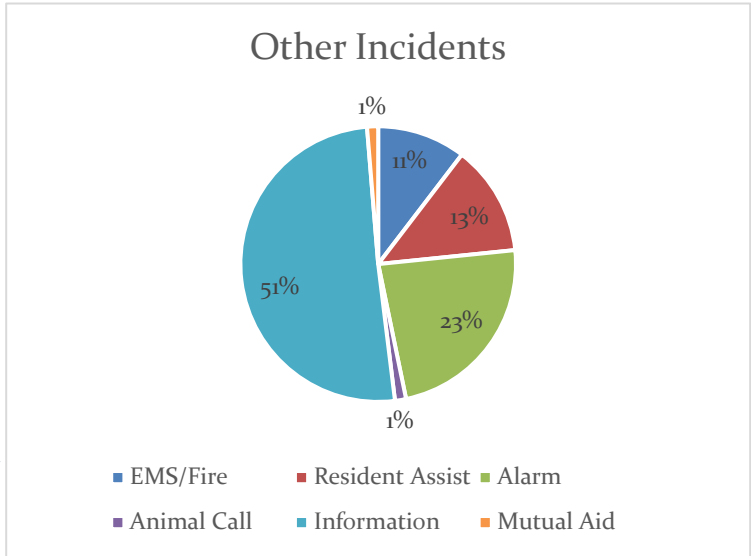
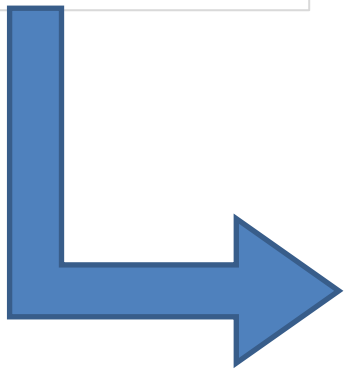
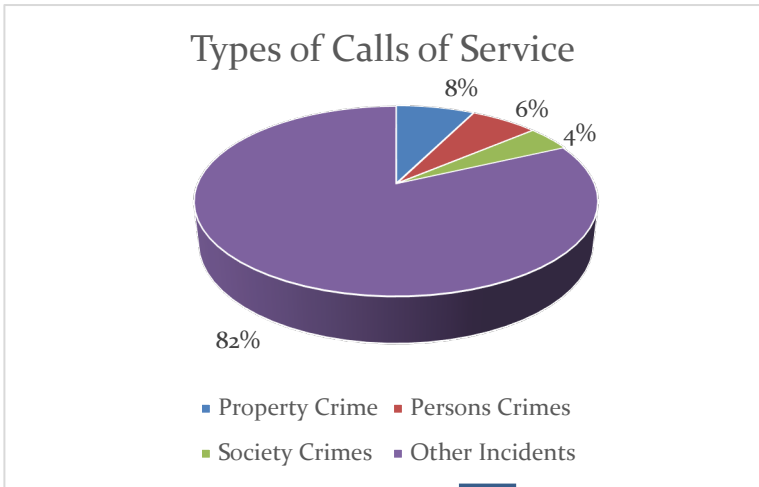
