The arrest data represents physical arrests and citations issued in lieu of an arrest.

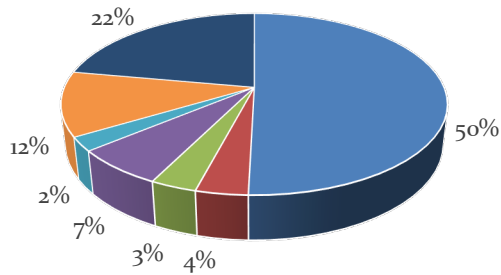
